1.0. Background information

The Holy Family Mission School Kapsowar started with very few pupils. It started gradually from baby class. It is located in **Marakwet West Constituency, Elgeyo Marakwet County, Rift Valley Province in Kenya**. It is located within the Holy Family Parish Kapsowar church compound. The school has been constantly increasing pupil enrolment and also have many teachers and has now reached class five. The general climatic condition of the area is warm with 12 hours sunshine a day. The school provides the 8.4.4. Curriculum as required by the Kenya Government.

2.0. Project Title – Construction of a dormitory

The school now intends to build a dormitory to house at least 100 pupils for boarding. The school is currently experiencing more enrolment of pupils from the entire sub-stations of the parish and therefore it's critical that this facility is important for the growth and management of the school.

3.0. Statement of the problem

Initially the school used to enroll only pupils from within Kapsowar town who are pure day scholars. Since the school has been doing well, there is demand from the surrounding community to bring their children to the school. There is need for the construction of a dormitory to accommodate the pupils who will be coming from other sub-parish station.

4.0. Project activities

The school intends to build a dormitory. This project is intended to take off as from - November to December 2017.

5.0. Project inputs

The Holy Family Parish is planning to mobilize funds to a tune of ksh300,000.00 through the sub-parish station.

6.0. Project outputs The project is expected to transform the school into a modern school with at least modern classrooms and good dormitory

7.0. Project Beneficiaries

The project will have both direct and indirect beneficiaries. This will include the pupils, teachers, parents and the community. The nearby centres will also benefit from the ready market provided by the school for their farm produce and businesses. Teachers will be stable due to good and conducive environment thus boost the school performance hence economic growth

8.0. Project implementation

The Project will be implemented in phases by the parents, teachers, community and the contractors. The resources will be sourced and utilized within the community and seek well-wishers for expertise and other resource.
