(mission, identity, activities, areas and countries of intervention)	The Philippines mission of the Dominican Sisters of Blessed Imelda started in March 1991. The Congregation aims to be at the service of CHILDREN and YOUTH giving special attention to Christian formation through social, pastoral and school ministry. Motivated by their love for the young people, the Dominican Sisters decided to put up the CENTER FOR THE CHILDREN AND THE YOUTH (2011) as a response to the material, human and spiritual poverty of children living in the slum area nearby the sisters' convent. This program aims to address children's need in their physical, social, emotional, academic and spiritual development. It caters children aged 3 to 18 years old, often found in the streets with little or no parental supervision because their parents are either working or tending to small scale livelihood activities as their means to support their daily needs. Most of these children are malnourished and sickly. They are also susceptible to the dangers of the street because they are left unattended.

In addition, since the parents are busy earning for a living, they are often unattended which makes them susceptible to danger and they lack social skills and good behavior. Therefore, the Feeding program was initiated in which, aside from providing healthy foods, children are also given the opportunity to learn basic hygienes, develop their social skills and good behavior.</p> <p>The Dominican Grantees are Elementary and High School students. Majority of them are academically struggling due to the unhealthy environment (many of them live in one small room which is not conducive for learning). Their class schedules are not regular due to lack of facilities and over populated schools. Their schedule is by shift (6am-12noon; 1pm-6pm). Many of them are non-reader though they are in the Fourth or Fifth Grade. The Sisters provide for them remediation classes, a time for social interaction through group activities and provide allowance for their school expenses.</p>

<p>The convent of the Dominican Sisters of Blessed Imelda is located at 181 Maginhawa St., Sikatuna Village Quezon City, in the parish of The Lord of Divine Mercy in the Diocese of Cubao. The total population the City as of 2015 is 2, 936, 160.</p> <p>The social status quo of the people living in the area is uplift. It is vividly observed that these people are commonly working in the government and professionals. But despite this booming situation of the people living within high fence still poverty is seen through the neighboring slum areas such as Brgy. Malaya, Botacan, Bliss 1 & 2, Libis, Pook Malinis and Lambak. They are our displaced people from the province who arrived in Manila to look for jobs to sustain their family in the province. The houses in these areas are commonly made up of light materials especially in Brgy. Pook Malinis and Botacan, Malaya, where there is no proper drainage and the place is prone to fire disaster and natural calamities because of the crowded shanties. Their life is very hard where people are living behind human condition, specially the children.</p> <p>Brgy. Sikatuna Village is under the parish of the Lord of Divine Mercy which was established twenty-five (25) years ago. It caters to seven (7) areas of the parish community wherein each community conducts several pastoral activities that aims in bringing parishioners closer to the Lord like providing formation that aims to train its members toward becoming evangelizers and mission-oriented servant leaders; communion of communities through the pastoral summit and; meaningful outreach activities such as medical-dental mission, gift-giving, and assistance to the disaster and natural victims in Brgy. Botacan.</p> <p>We would like to particularly mention the pastoral activities of the community where the Dominican Sisters of Blessed Imelda belongs, the Sikatuna, the Parish of the Lord of Divine Mercy (PLDM). Aside from the mentioned activities above, the parish propagates the Devotion to the Divine Mercy, facilitates in the enthronement of Divine Mercy in homes and actively engage in the Home Evangelization Program (HEP) also known as BEC.</p>

Though the people in the locality are generous and sensitive towards the needs of the poor, in the past year, it was quite difficult to tap them because the local Christian community was concerned in helping building the new convent</p>	

and parish center.


